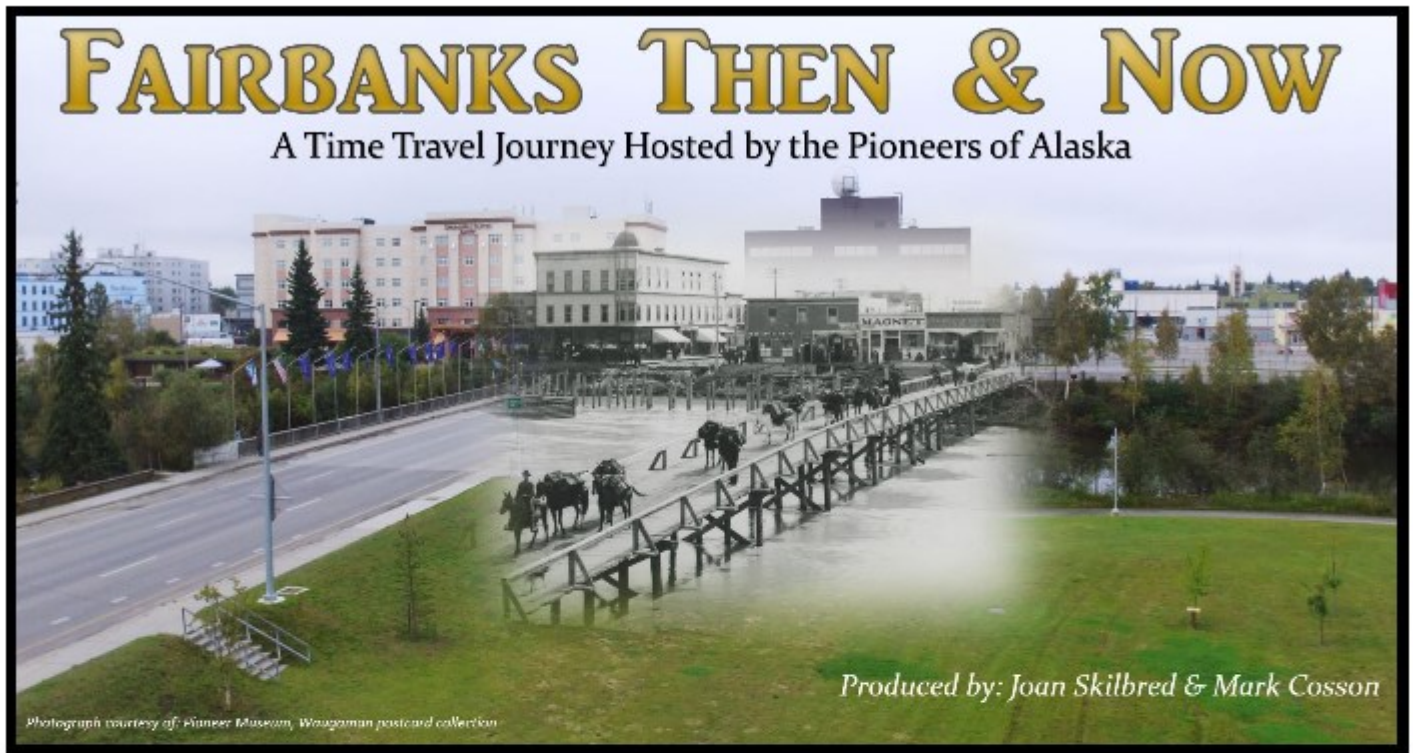


"FAIRBANKS THEN & NOW"
